


2024 PROPERTY TAX LEVY \$3,681,320





2024 General Fund Revenues \$2,979,834








Revenue Noteworthy Items

- Street Improvement Projects Fund 8% of proposed property tax levy
- ➤ Permits and Licenses stays consistent with 2023 making up approximately 2% of the budget
- Townships contract with the City for Fire Service 3%
- Intergovernmental Revenues increasing by 19% (640,551) from 2023 (517,631)

2024 Expenditures \$2,979,834

- > Streets
 - Railroad Street Reconstruction Project
 - One Inch Overlay Resurfacing Project
 - L7500 Dump Truck/Snowplow
- > Parks
 - Old Town Buildings Rebuilt at Willkommen Park
- > Economic Development
 - Infrastructure for the Tacoma West Industrial Park Phase 2
 - Walking Track at Central Schools
 - West Carver Community Pool House Improvements
- > Fire Department
 - Encrypted Radios



Your Property's Market Value

- The market value of your property helps determine how much you pay in property tax.
- Carver County sets the market value each year based on comparative property sales in the county.
- If you question your property valuation, look for your market value notice from the county in early 2024.
