Right-of-Way Permit Request Form Continued

All right of way work must be coordinated to protect the public interest. All traffic control will be in accordance with MnDOT specs and City of Norwood Young America requirements, contact Public Services Department 952-777-0274 for pre-work review of traffic control plan. Unless otherwise approved access to local areas, or detour, for residents must be maintained to standard throughout project.

Disturbed right of way/easement and surrounding areas will be protected and restored to same or better condition with alike street surface, curbing, topsoil and grass seed per city specs, coordinated with the Public Services Department for work inspection

Work hours within the City of Norwood Young America are 7am - 10pm Monday-Friday, 9am-10pm weekends and holidays. For after hours work contact the Public Services Department for more information and request procedure.

Permittee must notify residents/public that may be affected by this permit 5 working days prior to start of construction. Notice must be by signage, mail or personal contact.

All companies performing work in the right of way or easement area must have an up to date registration and insurance form on file with the City of Norwood Young America before applying for a right of way permit.

All work in the City of NYA right of way requires a contractor warranty of permitted work for a period not less than on year from the date of final inspection. Permit hold must coordinate with the Public Services Department for on site work inspection and final acceptance of work area.

In permit noider snail correct detects in patching or restorations performed by permit noider or permit noiders agents. The permit holder, upon notice from the City of NYA, shall correct all work necessary using an industry best practices method or as required by the City of NYA. Said work shall be completed within 5 days of receipt of notice from the City of NYA. If it is necessary for the City of NYA to restore the right of way/easement area, during the 12 months following such restoration, the permit holder shall pay to the city, within 30 days of billing all costs associated with correcting the defective work of permittee. These costs shall include but are not limited to administrative overhead, mobilization, material, labor, and equipment.

If the permit holder fails to restore public right of way/easement area in a manner and to the condition required by permit or fails to satisfactorily complete all restoration required in a timely manner, the City of NYA may notify the permit holder in writing of the failure or shortcomings. Then after 5 days, the City of NYA may complete all necessary work and bill the permittee. IF the city restores any part of the right of way/easement area due to the permit holder or permit holder agent's failure, the permittee shall pay that cost within 30 days of billing by the City of NYA. These costs shall include, but not limited to administrative overhead, mobilization, material, labor and equipment.

Permittee will provide project data necessary for the City of NYA to develop a right of way/easement mapping system in accordance with Minnesota Statute 237.162 subd 8 (6) 1998. Information required but not limited to location and elevation of applicant's mains, cables, conduits, switches and all related equipment and facilities, type, size and description of equipment plus all abandoned facilities.
